REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

**Architectural Services for the Renovation of Office Space in the
Wayne County Amster Frick Building and the
Wayne County Justice Center
Wooster, Wayne County, Ohio**

CLOSING DATE: October 7, 2016 at 2:00 p.m.

The Board of Wayne County Commissioners is currently accepting qualification statements from professional architects and architectural firms to provide professional services necessary for the renovation of office space at two county locations: 1) a portion of the Amster Frick Building at 117 West Liberty Street and 2) a portion of the Wayne County Justice Center at 201 West North Street. Both locations are in downtown Wooster, Ohio.

The Board is seeking qualified firms to provide interior space analysis, interior redesign, limited exterior redesign and cost estimates needed to renovate the areas. Location 1 will require modification to the entry way and building exterior and interior redesign of approximately 4565 sq. ft. of space. Location 2 will require expertise with justice and jail facilities to reallocate space previously occupied by the city police department.
