This improvement is to be completed by October 31, 2016. The Engineer's estimate for this project is \$202,850.

A non-refundable charge of \$30.00 will be required for each set of plans. Checks should be made payable to the Wayne County Engineer. Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experience on projects of similar size and complexity.

In accordance with ORC Section 153.54 each bidder must deposit with his bid, security in the amount, form, and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders. Bonds shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

This project is funded, in part, by the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC). All requirements of OPWC projects will apply. All contractors and subcontracts will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the construction of this project.

DOMESTIC STEEL USE REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 153.011 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE APPLY TO THIS PROJECT. COPIES OF SECTION 153.011 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE CAN BE OBTAINED FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES.

Contractor compliance with the Equal Employment Opportunity requirements of the Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and the Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Wayne County, Ohio as determined by the current Division of Labor and Worker Safety-Wage and Hour of the Ohio Department of Commerce.

The Board of Wayne County Commissioners may consider informal any bid not prepared and submitted in accordance with the provisions hereof. The Wayne County Commissioners reserve the right to waive any informality in the bidding and to reject any or all bids.

No bidder may withdraw a bid within sixty (60) days of the actual date of the opening thereof.
