

WAYNE COUNTY, OHIO

MARRIAGE LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

- Both parties of the marriage must apply together in person and at least one of the applicants must reside in Wayne County. If neither of the applicants reside in the State of Ohio, the Court will issue a license only if the marriage ceremony is to take place in Wayne County.
- The minimum age for applying without parental consent is eighteen (18) years of age. If either applicant is under the age of 18, call the Court for additional information and requirements.
- At the time of the application, each applicant must exhibit a birth certificate and a social security card. If one or both of the applicant(s) was previously married and divorced, a certified copy of the final decree for each previous marriage is required.
- The license is issued at the time of the application and the cost is \$45.00 **cash only**. This license can be used anywhere in the State of Ohio and is valid for sixty (60) days from the date of issuance. If the marriage does not take place within 60 days, a new license will need to be applied for. The fee is not refundable or transferable.
- The Court issues marriage licenses between the hours of 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM Monday through Friday. The Court is closed Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays.
- The Probate Court is located on the second floor of the Wayne County Courthouse at 107 West Liberty Street (Public Square), Wooster, Ohio.
