A member of the Wayne County Residential Building Board of Appeals would be responsible for hearing and deciding on code decisions made by the Residential Building Official, relative to the application and interpretation of the Residential Code of Ohio; and rendering all decisions in writing to the appellant, with a duplicate copy to the Building Official within 30 days of the hearing.

The Residential Building Board of Appeals only meets as needed, in response to a request for an appeal of a code interpretation rendered by the Building Official.

A Residential Building Board of Appeals member shall be qualified to sit on the board based on their experience and training, as it relates to building construction as required to render professional decisions. Examples of qualified individuals include contractors, retired code officials, fire fighters or someone with related construction field experience.
