Deputy Dog Warden (part-time)

Do you love working with dogs and have a passion for keeping Wayne County safe? The Wayne County Commissioners are currently accepting employment applications for the part-time position of Deputy Dog Warden. This position will work three to four (3-4) 8-hour days per week, which includes every other Saturday and will need to be on call for emergencies as required. The successful candidate will:

- Patrol the county and impound stray dogs.
- Issue warnings and citation to non-compliant dog owners.
- Conduct checks for and sell dog licenses.
- Respond to complaints or concerns from the public.
- Appear in Court as needed to testify as to the citations and/or cruelty investigations.
- Be comfortable working in all types of weather.
- Have knowledge of animal behavior and be comfortable working with and around dogs (including dangerous dogs).
- Plan routes for pickups.
- Answer telephones to help the public with dog-related problems and provide guidance.
- Attend meetings and trainings as needed.
- Maintain Dog Warden area and supplies to ensure efficient operation.
- Assist with cleaning duties and/or shelter operation duties, as necessary.
- Must have a valid driver's license and good driving record.
- Ohio Peace Officer Certification (OPOTA) is preferred.
