Winter Weather Advisory



OVERVIEW:

- Snow may be heavy at times tonight through Sunday.
- The greatest accumulations of 4-8 inches are expected south of a line from Bowling Green to Ashland.

TIMING

- Snow expected Saturday night through Sunday evening.
- The heaviest snow will occur between Midnight and Noon Sunday.

HAZARDS &

- Snowfall totals of 4 to 8 inches in the Winter Weather Advisory.
 Snowfall totals of 1 to 4 inches expected outside of the Winter Weather Advisory.
- Winds from the east will gust to 20-30 mph and will be highest near Lake Erie.
- Temperatures will be in upper 20s to lower 30s.
- Additional light snow will linger Sunday Night and Monday, mainly across eastern areas.

NWS ALERTS

- Winter Weather Advisory for Lucas, Wood Ottawa, Sandusky, Hancock, Seneca, Wyandot, Crawford, Marion, Morrow, Knox from 10 PM Saturday – 7 PM Sunday
- Winter Weather Advisory for Huron, Richland, Ashland, Wayne, Stark, Holmes I AM – 10 PM Sunday.

FORECAST CHALLENGES

- A few locations from Findlay to Marion may see higher snowfall amounts.
- Rising water levels are expected Sunday into Monday along the Lake Erie shoreline of Lucas, Ottawa, and Erie Counties. Minor flooding possible.
