Researches databases, reviews federal and state laws and rules, Ohio Administrative Code governing the child support program, and local procedures to enhance job performance and remain current on federal, state, and local rules and regulations regarding the child support enforcement program. Attends and represents the Child Support Enforcement Agency (CSEA) in matters before the court. Reviews cases and determines actions to be taken. Prepares various basic and complex legal documents independently. Participates in all meetings, trainings, and activities as a member of the CSEA Legal Department. Other duties as assigned.
