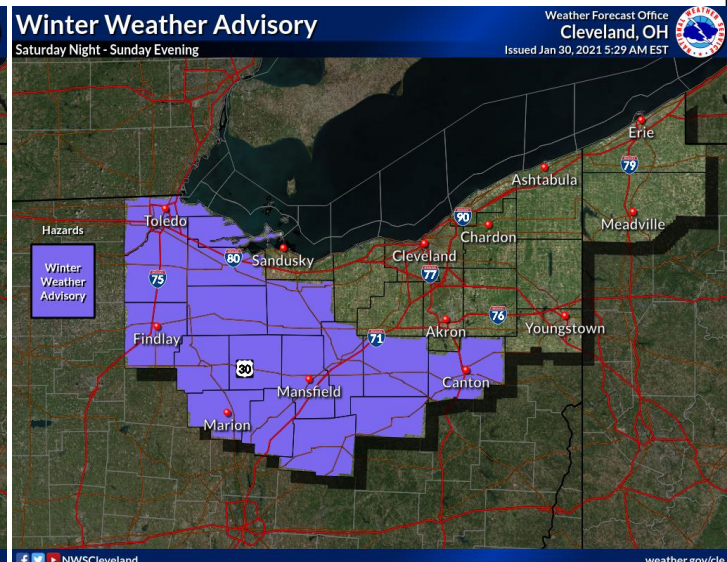

## OVERVIEW:

- Snow may be heavy at times tonight through Sunday.
- The greatest accumulations of 4-8 inches are expected south of a line from Bowling Green to Ashland.

| <b>TIMING</b>                | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Snow expected Saturday night through Sunday evening.</li><li>▪ The <u>heaviest snow</u> will occur between Midnight and Noon Sunday.</li></ul>  |
| <b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Snowfall totals of 4 to 8 inches in the Winter Weather Advisory. Snowfall totals of 1 to 4 inches expected outside of the Winter Weather Advisory.</li><li>▪ Winds from the east will gust to 20-30 mph and will be highest near Lake Erie.</li><li>▪ Temperatures will be in upper 20s to lower 30s.</li><li>▪ Additional light snow will linger Sunday Night and Monday, mainly across eastern areas.</li></ul> |
| <b>NWS ALERTS</b>            | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ <b>Winter Weather Advisory</b> for Lucas, Wood Ottawa, Sandusky, Hancock, Seneca, Wyandot, Crawford, Marion, Morrow, Knox from 10 PM Saturday – 7 PM Sunday</li><li>▪ <b>Winter Weather Advisory</b> for Huron, Richland, Ashland, Wayne, Stark, Holmes 1 AM – 10 PM Sunday.</li></ul>  |
| <b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ A few locations from Findlay to Marion may see higher snowfall amounts.</li><li>▪ Rising water levels are expected Sunday into Monday along the Lake Erie shoreline of Lucas, Ottawa, and Erie Counties. Minor flooding possible.</li></ul>   |
