305.30(G))

WHEREAS, pursuant to Division (G) of ORC section 305.30, the County Administrator is authorized to contract on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners of Wayne County, Ohio, within limits provided by resolution of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned resolution shall specify the types of contracts upon which the County Administrator may act without further resolution of the Board; and.

WHEREAS, the official business carried out by Wayne County regularly requires the Board to execute various agreements and associated documentation concerning or related to claims and/or settlements; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it in the best interest of the operations of Wayne County to delegate to the County Administrator the authority to execute, on behalf of the Board and without limitation, any and all agreements and associated documentation concerning or related to Claims, including, but not limited to, Insurance Claims and/or Settlements, Workers' Compensation Claims and/or Settlements, and Lawsuits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Wayne County, Ohio, that:

- Section 1. The County Administrator, on behalf of the Board, and without limitation, is authorized to execute any and all agreements and associated documentation concerning or related to Claims, including, but not limited to, Insurance Claims and/or Settlements, Workers' Compensation Claims and/or Settlements, and Lawsuits. This authority is limited to claims up to and including Twenty-Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) per claim.
- Section 2. The Board of Wayne County Commissioners hereby incorporate into this resolution all of the aforesaid recitals and they are rendered to be findings by the Board.
- Section 3. The Board of Wayne County Commissioners also finds that all formal actions of its Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of this Board that was properly noticed.
